

## Parks Seasonal Labourer (3 Month Contract)

Infrastructure Services Department

### Job Description:

Reporting to the Public Works Supervisors, the Parks Seasonal Labourer is responsible for performing general maintenance duties at outdoor sports fields, cleaning and sanitizing of washroom facilities and litter/debris pickup from municipal property while ensuring attractive, orderly, and well-maintained park areas to provide a pleasant outdoor environment for all users and visitors. Hours may vary depending on weather conditions. Evening and weekend hours are a requirement.

### Specific Duties:

- Daily maintenance and cleaning of splash pad, amphitheatre, concession area, park grounds, trails and municipal properties including grass cutting, trimming and weeding.
- Daily, ongoing litter and debris pickup, maintenance and cleaning of parking lots and public spaces.
- Setup and cleanup for pavilion rentals and special events hosted at municipal parks and facilities.
- Maintain stock and supplies for various park facilities.
- Daily opening, closing and on-going cleaning and sanitizing of park washroom facilities.
- Provide friendly customer service to members of the community, tourists and user-groups.
- Daily watering of hanging baskets, planters and gardens as required.
- Complete daily inspections/activity logs of park areas.
- Comply with Occupational Health and Safety Act (OHSA) requirements as well as the Municipality's Health and Safety Program.
- Other duties as assigned.

### Qualifications:

- Must have a secondary school diploma or equivalent GED, or post-secondary education.
- Must demonstrate an ability to perform a variety of manual tasks related to the Public Works Division.
- Must be able to reach overhead, or lift heavy items for long periods.
- Must possess a valid G2 Ontario Drivers Licence.
- Experience driving full-sized pickups, large trucks, and pulling trailers is an asset.
- Must have experience with operation of utility tractors/riding lawn mowers and weed eaters.
- Knowledge of lawn, sports field maintenance and experience is an asset.
- Familiarity with a construction environment and techniques considered an asset.
- Must obtain a satisfactory police clearance upon hire.

### Hours of Work:

40 hours per week (Sunday to Saturday). Evening, weekend and holiday hours are a requirement.

Seasonal, Non-Union.

### Salary:

\$18.73 per hour (2021 Rates).
